Day of Prayer for Human Life: Next Sunday we celebrate the Day of prayer for Human Life. This is the day in the Church's year dedicated to celebrating the sacredness of life. The proceeds from the Day of Life collection provide core funding for the Anscombe Bioethics Centre and to assist other life related activities supported by the Church, usually by means of grants made to support Catholic charities working in the particular field determined by the theme of the year

Celebrating the Sacraments: Over the last two weekends we have had the joy of welcoming four young children into our Sacred Heart community. Brothers Jago and Hugo were baptised on Saturday May 29th, Freja on Saturday June 5th and Antonina on Sunday June 6th, and in the coming weeks another 10 children are due to be baptised. Last Sunday afternoon 27 children from our parish began their journey of preparation for the Sacraments of Reconciliation and first Holy Communion, and this Saturday 34 of our teenagers began their journey of preparation for the Sacrament of Confirmation. First Communions will be celebrated on 9th/10th October and Confirmation on Sunday 28th November. Please keep our children and young people and their families in your prayers, and also our group of catechists who are so generously and enthusiastically passing on our Faith to them.

Priestly Ordination of Bro Greg SDB and Bro Joe SDB: On Saturday 26th June Bro Greg and Bro Joe will be ordained to the priesthood here at Sacred Heart Church. Sadly, due to covid restrictions we are unable to extend an invitation to all parishioners for this occasion. However, our two parishes have each been allocated 10 places to enable 10 parishioners from each parish to attend the ordination mass. If you would like to be one of the ten from this parish you are invited next week or the week after to place you name into the ballot box which will be located outside the parish office. We will draw out 10 names at the end of the 11.30am Mass on Sunday 20th June.
