16th February 2020 - SIXTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

In many ways our reading today reflect the gift of free will and choice: Sirach tells us that we have to choose between **death and life**. We may make choices based on wanting to fit in or to be liked or to even exercise control over others. Sometimes our choices are based on self preservation or on the needs of our family, partner or children; we can even work out of jealousy or revenge. So this week we are invited to reflect on **what will bring us life and energy?** What will bring us closer to God and others as we journey through this coming week? Am I going to try and build others up by words and actions towards them and make them feel so worthwhile? Or am I going to be mean and destructive, leaving them distressed and alone? The choice is ours, but Jesus encourages to follow that life-giving Law of God that will give hope to each other and bring us all closer to the family of our Church. As we choose life, so we choose the love of God that builds us all up to where we are called to be. The modern Irish prophet and poet, John O 'Donohue writes so simply when he says:

**If you send out goodness from yourself, or if you share that which is happy or good within you, it will all come back to you multiplied ten thousand times. In the kingdom of love there is no competition; there is no possessiveness or control. The more love you give away, the more love you will have.**

### **EU Settlement Scheme**



This is important information for all EU citizens and may be helpful to London based staff members, volunteers and parishioners. The deadline to apply for the EU Settlement Scheme is the 30th June 2021. This is to give EU citizens either settled or pre-settled status protection according to UK laws, after the UK leaves the EU. The type of status awarded will depend on how long the person has lived in the UK.
